During our 10-day exchange in Vienna, young people from five different countries come together to reflect on one of today's most important challenges: sustainability. Through discussions, workshops, and group activities, we explore how our everyday choices affect the planet and how we can contribute to a greener future.

We talk about issues such as climate change, pollution, responsible consumption, and the role we play in protecting our environment. Everyone shares perspectives shaped by their own culture and daily life, creating a rich and diverse learning experience.



ACTIVITIES AND WORKSHOPS

LEARNING THROUGH SHARED EXPERIENCES

The project is based on non-formal education, which means we learn not only by listening but by doing. This approach encourages collaboration, creativity, and open communication. Participants exchange their views on environmental challenges in their home countries, discovering both differences and shared goals. The experience shows how cooperation across cultures can inspire new ideas and meaningful solutions.

ENVIRONMENT

LEARNING THROUGH EXPERIENCE

We take part in several activities that help us learn about sustainability in a practical way. We interview people to hear different opinions, clean public areas and use the collected waste to create upcycled crafts, join roleplay sessions to explore environmental issues, and enjoy cultural nights where

each country presents its traditions. These activities strengthen our teamwork, creativity, and sense of community.
